Research is clear: when teachers are trained in the science of reading, and a school-wide plan is implemented with fidelity, student outcomes improve dramatically.

That's why the Milwaukee Reading Coalition is focused on instruction. The Coalition will support early-grade teachers and school leaders across all sectors in Milwaukee. Literacy coaches will work alongside them in classrooms to build sustainable, long-term support.
